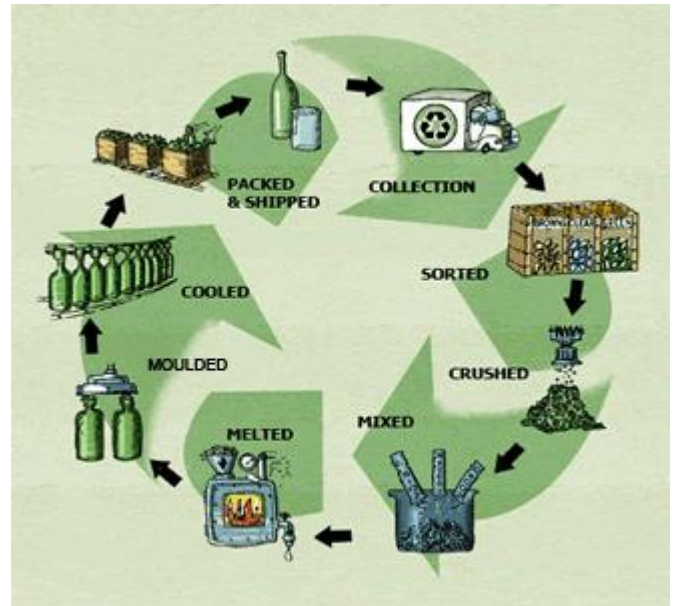


The life cycle of a glass container

1. **To start off**, the consumer **throws glass** into a recycle bin.
2. **Then**, the glass is **transported** from the bin and taken to a glass treatment plant.
3. **Later**, the glass is **sorted** by colour
4. **After** that, it is **washed** to remove any impurities.
5. **Next**, the glass is **crushed**
6. **Thus**, it is **mixed**.
7. **Then**, it is **melted**
8. **Once** it is melted, it is moulded into new products such as bottles and jars.
9. **Finally**, the glass is then **sent back to the shops** ready to be used again.



Note: Glass does not degrade through the recycling process, so it can be recycled again and again.
