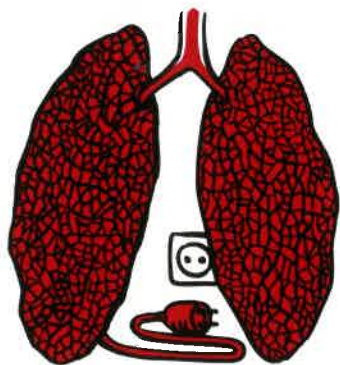


Since the hospital could do no more for her husband he was moved back home and kept alive by an artificial respirator.
